Support to BNHA legal case



MOGS General Body Meeting

The Mid Year General Body meeting of MOGS was held on September 25, 2011. At this meeting the final MOGS Accounts and financial resolutions for 2010-2011 were approved, a midyear report of activities undertaken this year was presented, Managing Council recommendations for Honorary Fellowship and MOGS awards, MOGS Vision and Mission statements were ratified and support extended to the Nursing Home Owners association. In landmark decisions the General Body approved a constitutional change for postal ballot for MOGS elections, a resolution to make voting for all available positions mandatory and a Managing Council recommendation to place a member under temporary suspension for serious violation of the PC PNDT Act.
