

YOUTH MELA

India today, with over 1.21 billion people (2011 census), has more than a sixth of the world's population. India has more than 50% of its population below the age of 25. Every third person in an Indian city today is a youth, but there are social & spatial inequalities prevailing. While income levels in cities may appear to be higher, the cost of living is also constantly increasing, resulting in shrinking savings, inadequate access to health care & lack of quality education. Maternal mortality remains the 'top cause of death among young women. Further, more than half of young urban women are anaemic, pointing to inadequate food & nutrition.

The youth of today are the future of tomorrow's India.

In the last few years, due to socio-economic and political factors, there have been increasing health problems among the youth.

Today, the youth in India form one of the most vulnerable groups, who on the one hand are expected to be the leaders to determine the destiny of India, and on the other hand, are an exploited and confused group. Today's youth has access to the internet but there are many queries in their mind about reproductive health and social issues, myths prevail & many questions are unanswered. Most are not very comfortable talking to their parents about it and depend a lot on the peers for information which may not always be practical. Empowering the youth with awareness and knowledge is the need of the hour so this initiative .

Following topics are addressed in the YOUTH mela:

- 1. Grooming & Communication skills: To help them present themselves better at both personal and professional level.
- 2 Healthy Diet and prevention of anemia: for promoting good health and prevention of anemia; a healthy mind resides in a healthy body
- 3. Know Your Body: gives knowledge about the reproductive organs.
- 4. Staying fit
- 5. Prevention of unwanted Pregnancy: Problems associated with it, by use of contraception.
- 6. Prevention of HIV/ Sexually Transmitted Infections/Cancer Cervix: By promoting abstinence and correct use of contraception as well as vaccines for preventing Cancer Cervix.
- 7. Prevention from sexual abuse: With the rise of violence against women this is the need of the hour.
- 8. Self-defence Techniques: Needed by both boys and girls as a survival skill.
- 9 First Aid: for anyone and everyone this is a basic skill needed to help themselves and the society in case of accidents as well as disasters.

We have a pretest and post test questionnaire to assess the impact of our sessions on their minds. Lacunae in understanding are addressed and also is followed by Questions and answers, solving queries and are very interactive.

Satisfying their guest for knowledge will certainly help them to cope with challenges of life. We hope to channelize their energy in the right direction helping them to become responsible citizens. FOGSI's Youth Mela helps in empowering them..the right way forward!












ANNUAL REPORT 2013 - 2014
