Receipts towards the various program was Rs.82,07,052.54, Academic/Educational Grants received during the year was 10,41,0168/-. The surplus during the year for appropriation was Rs. 36,36,319/-.


I began my journey as an MD by studying the books of the legendary Dr. C.S Dawn and was fortunate enough to meet him, which was my desire.
